Things we might do to bring in the Kingdom in South & London Questions & suggestions:

Is there a possible connection: St Albans, Luton, Chesham?

How to get traction? To get groups moving from disinterest to engagement?

How often should groups meet for prayer? Weekly is a good target to gain momentum. However, time and other church commitments need to be acknowledged. Local groups should aim for us much as they can, but make their own decisions about what is possible at this given time.

Practical suggestions:

Attributes needed: Boldness to share the gospel. Loving relationships.

Book and DVD table in the High Street. Time for people. Treasure hunting.

Friendship Group for women.

Men going to meet men on the street – street Pastor style.

Prayer walking.

Networking:

Connecting Together in the South. Getting the coordinators together.

Connecting Together in London – The coordinators.

Gathering and envisioning events in our regions to recruit more people

Post prayer requests on the city.

Invite Muslim Background believers to share at Mahabba events to inspire people and for people to support them.
